Is maith liom é.	(iss mah lyum ey)	I like it.
Is maith leat é.	(iss mah lyat ey)	You like it.
Is maith leis é.	(iss mah lesh ey)	He likes it.
Is maith léi é.	(iss mah lay ey)	She likes it.
Is maith linn é.	(iss mah ling ey)	We like it.
Is maith libh é.	(iss mah liv ey)	You like it.
Is maith leo é.	(iss mah lyoe ey)	They like it.

Is maith le Mícheál é.	(iss mah leh mee-hawl ey)	Michael likes it.
Is maith le Máire é.	(iss mah le moy-ruh ey)	Mary likes it.
Is maith leis an bhfear é.	(iss mah lesh un var ey)	The man likes it.
Is maith leis an mbean é.	(iss mah lesh un man ey)	The woman likes it.
Is maith leis na ceoltóirí é.	(iss mah lesh nuh kyoel-tor-ee ey)	The musicians like it.
Is maith leis í.	(iss mah lesh ee)	He likes her.
Is maith léi é.	(iss mah lay ey)	She likes him.
Is maith linn iad.	(iss mah ling ee-ud)	We like them.

Is maith léi briosaí.	(iss mah lay briss-kee)	She likes cookies.
An maith leat iad?	(un mah lyat ee-ud)	Do you like them?
Ní maith linn úlla.	(nee mah linn oolah)	We don't like apples.

Nach maith leo an aimsir?
(nakh mah lyoe un am-shir)
Don't they like the weather?

Is maith liom laethanta grianmhara.
(iss mah lyum lay-hen-tuh green-wur-uh)
I like sunny days.

Ní maith leis na gardaí gadaithe.
(nee mah lesh nuh gar-dee god-ee-huh)
The police don't like thieves.

Nach maith leis na páistí briosaí?
(nakh mah lesh nuh pawsh-chee briss-kee)
Don't the children like cookies?
