(un mah lyat shkal-oeg-ah)
Do you like french fries?
- B: **Is maith. Is maith liom iad.**
(iss mah; iss mah lyum ee-ud)
Yes. I like them.
- A: **Nach maith leat glasraí freisin?**
(nakh mah lyat gloss-ree fresh-in)
Don't you like vegetables, too?
- B: **Ní maith. Ní maith liom glasraí.**
(nee mah; nee mah lyum gloss-ree)
No. I don't like vegetables.
- #3** A: **An maith leat iasc?**
(un mah lyat eesk)
Do you like fish?
- B: **Ní maith liom ar chor ar bith é.**
(nee mah lyum air khor air bih ey)
I don't like it at all.
- Is fearr liom sicín.**
(iss fawr lyum shick-een)
I prefer chicken.
- A: **Is fuath liomsa sicín.**
(iss foo-ah lyum-sah shick-een)
I hate chicken.
- An maith leat mairteoil?**
(un mah lyat march-yoel)
Do you like beef?
- B: **Is maith.**
(iss mah)
Yes.
- A: **Beidh mairteoil againn, mar sin.**
(bay march-yoel oggeen, mar shin)
We'll have beef, then.

- #1 A: **An ceoltóir tú?**
(un kyoel-tor too)
Are you a musician?
- B: **Ní h-ea. Is rinneoir mé.**
(nee hah; iss rink-yor may))
No. I'm a dancer
- A: **Nach rinneoir í Máire?**
(nakh rink-yor ee moy-ruh)
Isn't Mary a dancer?
- B: **Is ea. Is rinneoir maith í.**
(shah; iss rink-yor mah ee)
Yes. She's a good dancer.

Agus is amhránaí iontach í freisin, nach ea?
(oggus iss ow-raw-nee een-takh ee fresh-in, nakh ah)
And she's a good singer, too, isn't she?

- A: **Is ea, cinnte.**
(shah, keen-chuh)
She certainly is.
