

Examples using “**ag éirí**”:

**Tá sé ag éirí te.**

(taw shay egg ay-ree cheh)

It's getting hot.

[It's rising hot.]

**Tá sé ag éirí déanach.**

(taw shay egg ay-ree jane-akh)

It's getting late.

[It's rising late.]

**Tá mé ag éirí ramhar.**

(taw may egg ay-ree ra-wer)

I'm getting fat.

[I'm rising fat.]

**Tá tú ag éirí láidir.**

(taw too egg ay-ree law-ger)

You're getting strong.

[You're rising strong.]

**Tá an aimsir ag éirí scamallach.**

(taw un am-shir egg ay-ree skom-al-akh)

The weather is getting cloudy.

[The weather is rising cloudy.]

**Tá an buachaill ag éirí leisciúil.**

(taw un boo-khal egg ay-ree lesh-kyool)

The boy is getting lazy.

[The boy is rising lazy.]

**Níl siad ag éirí ciúin.**

(neel shee-ud egg ay-ree kyoo-in)

They're not getting quiet.

[They're not rising quiet.]

**An bhfuil an oíche ag éirí fuar?**

(un will un ee-khuh egg ay-ree foor)

Is the night getting cold?

[Is the night rising cold?]

**Nach raibh an lá ag éirí geal?**

(nakh rev un law egg ay-ree gyal)

Wasn't the day getting bright?

[Wasn't the day rising bright?]
