

1. Cad atá agat? What do you have?
Tá cat agam. I have a cat.
Níl madra agam. I don't have a dog.
An bhfuil cat agat? Do you have a cat?
Nach bhfuil madra agat? Don't you have a dog?

Tá. Yes (after question with *an bhfuil*).
Níl. No (after question with *an bhfuil*).

Cén saghas peata atá agat? What kind of pet do you have?

2. Cad atá ag Seán? What does John have?
Tá cat aige. He has a cat.

An bhfuil madra ag Máire? Does Mary have a dog?
Níl. Níl peata ar bith aici. No. She doesn't have any pet.

An bhfuil peataí agaibh? Do y'all have pets?
Tá. Tá cait agus madraí againn. Yes. We have cats and dogs.

Tá <u>peata</u> agam.	I have <u>a pet</u> .	Tá <u>peata</u> againn.	We have <u>a pet</u> .
Tá <u>peata</u> agat.	You have <u>a pet</u> .	Tá <u>peata</u> agaibh.	Ye have <u>a pet</u> .
Tá <u>peata</u> aige.	He has <u>a pet</u> .	Tá <u>peata</u> acu.	They have <u>a pet</u> .
Tá <u>peata</u> aici.	She has <u>a pet</u> .	Tá <u>peata</u> ag Seán.	Sean has <u>a pet</u> .

3. An bhfuil peata ag aon duine? Does anyone have a pet?
Tá. Tá ceann agamsa. Yes. I have one.

Cé aige a bhfuil peata? Who has a pet?
Tá ceann ag Seán. John has one.
4. Cad a bhí agat? What did you have?
Bhí cat agam. I had a cat.
Ní raibh madra agam. I didn't have a dog.
An raibh cat agat? Did you have a cat?
Nach raibh mada agat? Didn't you have a dog?

Bhí. Yes (after question with *an raibh*).
Ní raibh. No (after question with *an raibh*).

Cén saghas peata a bhí agat? What kind of pet did you have?

Comhrá 1

A: Cad atá agat?

B: Tá peata agam.

A: An bhfuil cat agat?

B: Níl. Níl cat agam.

A: Cén saghas peata atá agat?

B: Tá madra agam.

Comhrá 2

A: An bhfuil peann ag aon duine anseo?

B: Níl. Ach, tá peann luaidhe ag Máire.

A: An bhfuil clúdach litreach aici freisin?

B: Tá. Tá ceann aici.

Comhrá 3

A: An bhfuil peann agaibh?

B: Níl peann agamsa, ach bhí ceann ag *Seán*.

A: An bhfuil peann agatsa, a *Sheáin*?

C: Bhí, ach níl sé agam anois.

B: Nach raibh peann luaidhe agat?

C: Bhí. Agus tá sé agam go fóill. Seo duit.

A: Go raibh maith agat.

Comhrá 4

S: Dia duit, a Mháire.

M: Dia 's Muire duit, a Sheáin.

S: Conas tá tú?

M: Tá mé go maith, ach tá tart orm.

S: An raibh tú amuigh?

M: Bhí, agus ní raibh uisce agam.

S: Ar mhaith leat cupán líomanáide?

M: Ba mhaith, le do thoil.

S: ... Seo duit.

M: Go raibh maith agat.

S: Tá fáilte romhat.

M: ... An bhfuil naipcín agat?

S: Tá. Seo duit.

M: Go raibh míle maith agat.

S: ... Slán leat, a Mháire.

M: Slán agat.

Conversation 1

What do you have?

I have a pet.

Do you have a cat?

No, I don't have a cat.

What kind of pet do you have?

I have a dog.

Conversation 2

Does anyone here have a pen?

No, but Mary has a pencil.

Does she have an envelope too?

Yes, she has one.

Conversation 3

Do y'all have a pen?

I don't have a pen, but *John* had one.

Do you have a pen, *John*?

I had one, but I don't have it now.

Didn't you have a pencil.

Yes. And I still have it. Here you are.

Thank you.

Conversation 4

Hi, Mary.

Hi Sean.

How are you?

I'm fine, but I'm thirsty.

Were you outside?

Yes, and I didn't have water.

Would you like a cup of lemonade?

I would, please.

... Here you are.

Thank you.

You're welcome.

... Do you have a napkin?

Yes. Here you are.

Thanks a lot.

Bye, Mary.
