Conversation with Éamon Ó Cuív

God bless you and welcome to this week's program.

It's the Member of Parliament Éamon Ó Cuív who will be speaking with me on this program tonight.

His father was Brian from Dublin and his mother was Emer, daughter of Éamon de Valera.

He was working in Dublin at the beginning of the seventies, but in the year 1973 he said to himself, that day, "I'll set sail for the Joyce Country early in the morning."

And he came to Cornamona and he was working there in the cooperative until he became involved in politics in the year 1983.

Welcome, Éamon.

Thank you very much.

Did you get the job when you came up as manager of the cooperative?

Yes, but the cooperative at the time was just me, a committee and £3,500 as it was at the time, old pounds as you would say, as it was at the time. The cooperative. That's what the cooperative was.

And I came, I remember coming up and it was a frosty day, or a frosty evening.

And I came up to Cornamona.

But it was in a hall that there was a committee meeting on New Year's Eve of the year (19)73.

And of course it was a holiday on the first day of January and I began working on the second of January of '74.

And the cooperative was nothing.

And what was said to me to do, that they wanted to build a grazing place for 2,000 sheep.

And that was the proposal we had.
