Ceannaíonn / Ní cheannaíonn Yes / No

2. Cad a dhéanann tú ar maidin? What do you do in the morning?
Éiríonn mé ag a sé a chlog. I get up at six o'clock.
Ólann mé cupán tae. I drink a cup of tea.
Itheann mé leite le tósta. I eat oatmeal with toast.

3. Cá dtéann tú ar an deireadh seachtaine? Where do you go on the weekend?
Téann mé go dtí an trá. I go to the beach.
Téann mé amach ag siúl. I go out walking.
